FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE**InfraWare Reveals Roadmap for Medical Transcription Software**

TERRE HAUTE, Ind. (Jan. 27, 2009) – InfraWare, Inc., one of the medical transcription industry's fastest-growing ASP software companies, today announced the next versions of its popular applications for dictation and transcription, the InfraWare Dictation Client (IDC) and the InfraWare Transcription Client (ITC) respectively.

Both applications will be released in a Version 2009 package in the near future. The IDC will be released first with beta versions available in February and a full release in March. "The ITC release will follow by about 30 days", said Eric Montgomery, InfraWare V.P. of Product Development. "In addition to a visual face-lift, both applications are getting feature enhancements based on customer suggestions and will have significant enhancements under the hood." One of the most fundamental changes to the architecture of the applications has been a change to the database they use to store information. The new database allows the applications to install faster and consume fewer resources.

The company's web-based applications, including the InfraWare Management Console (IMC) and the EHR Web Portal received major updates in 2008. "InfraWare listens closely to customer suggestions for new feature ideas, and we believe strongly in keeping our products up to date to work with the latest versions of Windows and Internet Explorer", said InfraWare CEO Nick Mahurin.

The InfraWare Dictation Client, used by physicians to dictate into a PC or to upload recorded dictations from handheld digital recorders, is planned to get the following highlighted enhancements:

- Fresh User Interface: New screens and intuitive actions reduce the need for clicks and screen changes.
- Easier operation: Job properties can be changed individually or en masse from the main window. The retrieval process can now read the header of a DSS file to determine author and work type, and can it be configured to poll a folder for new audio files.





- Recording and playback: USB playback pedals can be used to control recording into a microphone. Playback and volume controls are controllable via mouse or keyboard shortcut keys.
- Easier installation scenarios: Many system requirements have been eliminated or made optional, including: sound card, microphone or sound input device, MS SQL Express and associated system requirements. Windows Vista (both 32-bit and 64-bit) will be supported in addition to Windows XP.

The InfraWare Transcription Client, used by medical transcriptionists to transcribe and perform quality control edits of dictated medical reports, is planned to contain the following enhancements:



- Pitch control setting as a customizable user setting.
 - Updated editor with refined user interface including more powerful context-sensitive menus and features.
 - Updated medical spell check dictionary (word list) and enhanced spell check interaction with the editor canvas.
 - Faster job downloads based on smaller audio files.
- Easier installation scenarios: MS SQL Express and associated system requirements will no longer be required. Windows Vista (both 32-bit and 64-bit) will be supported in addition to Windows XP.

In an extended outlook of InfraWare's technology roadmap, the company announced that there will be news for the company's next generation of [speech recognition technology](#) soon. In Q2 2009, customers can expect some exciting announcements regarding the capabilities and timeline of new technologies emerging from R&D.
