TERRE HAUTE, Ind. (Feb. 27, 2009) – InfraWare, Inc. announced the production release of the InfraWare Dictation Client (IDC) Version 2009 today, somewhat ahead of the scheduled March release.

“The beta was very well received”, commented CEO Nick Mahurin. “Customers gave the beta product high marks for innovation and usability. They also found several opportunities for improvement that developers were able to integrate in short order.”

The InfraWare Dictation Client, or IDC, is used by physicians to dictate into a PC or to upload recorded dictations from digital handheld recorders. Version 2009 replaces Version 2006 and has the following enhancements:

- Fresh User Interface: New screens and intuitive actions reduce the need for clicks and screen changes.
- Easier operation: Job properties can be changed individually or en masse from the main window.
- Recording and playback: USB playback pedals can be used to control recording into a microphone. Playback and volume controls are controllable via mouse or keyboard shortcut keys.
- Easier installation scenarios: Many system requirements have been eliminated or made optional, including: sound card, microphone or sound input device, MS SQL Express and associated system requirements. Windows Vista (both 32-bit and 64-bit) is supported in addition to Windows XP.
- New job status availability from via secure link to previously uploaded jobs in the EHR Web Portal.
- Barcode compatibility for capturing the subject of a dictation when dictating into the PC.
- New Olympus compatibility including support for the new DS2 file format in addition to the DSS format and the ability to read author and work type data encoded in files. Audio conversion





utility from DS2 or DSS to WAV format added. (Some features require the Olympus DSS Player software to be installed.)

- Keystroke shortcuts are active and customizable for most actions.
- Recording controls (record, rewind, fast-forward) can now be operated by standard USB pedals.
- New ability to backup and restore custom user settings.

In addition, the company announced that the IDC Version 2006 will reach end-of-life and become unsupported on December 31, 2009. All customers licensed for Version 2006 of the IDC are automatically eligible for an upgrade to Version 2009. No customer action is necessary to take advantage of the license upgrade. The new version can be installed by registered users from the InfraWare Management Console (IMC).
